

Student Affairs Subcommittee

- Goal is to provide as many student services locally as possible.
- Student Affairs staff at each campus would include an assistant dean along with 3-4 staff providing site administration, registrar, financial aid and student services functions.
- Facilities for students being addressed by facilities committee
- COM global events, such as White Coat, Convocation, Research Day and Graduation, would be held locally to include the faculty and staff at each site.
- Each campus would have Medical Student Government Association representatives that meet monthly. All three campuses would meet quarterly, on rotating basis. (see attachment designed by M4 students)
- The current 40+ student interest groups do not need to be duplicated at each site, but would suggest having fewer interest groups which cover a broad spectrum of specialties, such as primary care
 - Students interested in specific interest groups would have the opportunity to call into interest group meetings
- Each campus would need to have its own Professional Code Committee.
- Curriculum oversight must be centered in Lexington with student representation from each class at each campus having the ability to connect via telemedicine.
- Will defer to the Admissions subcommittee to discuss student involvement.
- Research opportunities must be made available at both regional campuses. IRB approval will have to be obtained through UK and the local sites.
- Tutoring must be available at all campuses. This is normally provided by upper-level students. However, in the early years of the program when there are no upper-level students, this may need to be done via telemedicine by students in Lexington or faculty at each campus.
- The selection of AOA Honor Medical Society and Gold Humanism Honor Society is based on the total number of students in the College of Medicine. Each campus may elect students based on its % of the total students enrolled.
- Students would have access to all UK library online resources, textbooks, etc. Students would also need to have access to a medical librarian in some format at their specific site.
- Student health and wellness services as well as career/academic counseling and shadowing provided locally. Need to assure that mental health counseling is not provided by faculty that will grade the student in clerkships.
